Friday from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m. June 3-28. Meals will **not** be served but concessions will be available.



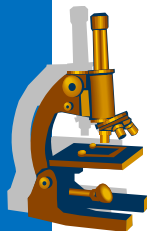
Transportation will be provided to pick up points throughout the Goldonna and Fairview Elementary school districts.

Students enrolled in the Project 212 after-school program will have the opportunity to participate

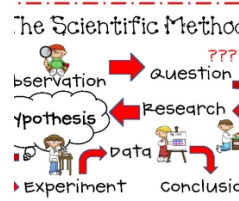
