SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

One scholarship will be awarded each academic school year to a graduate of Natchitoches Central High School or Lakeview High School with a 2.5 and above grade point average. The applicant must enroll in a College or University.

HOW TO APPLY:

To apply for this scholarship, the applicant must submit the following items to the school counselor. The application packet must be returned by December 2, 2019 to the counselor. The application packet must include:

1. A complete application form.
2. An official high school transcript.
3. An official copy of ACT scores.
4. Two letters of recommendation from community leaders (community leaders include individuals that know the applicant personally such as teachers, employers, church leaders, coaches, etc.)
5. An essay that describes why the scholarship is important to you and why you should be the recipient of such a scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION:

1. One scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 (\$500.00 per recipient) will be awarded per academic school year.
2. The applicant must provide documentation of a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 grade point scale.
3. The scholarship is limited to the applicant's freshman year of college.
4. The scholarship will be awarded annually on the night of the annual "Party with a Purpose" hosted by Attorney Cloyd Benjamin Jr. and the Dreams Scholarship Fund, Inc.
5. Recipients must be present at the annual "Party with a Purpose" in order to receive the scholarship.
