English Language Arts	<p>Reading/ELA Monday: ELA Login to your Clever.com Account. Go to MyOn: Read one book on your Lexile level AND complete quiz. You need to score at least 80% on the quiz. **Continue reading 1 book per day on MyOn this week and take the quiz for the book you read. I will be tracking you to see how awesome you are doing!</p> <p>Tuesday: Access Common Lit: Read <i>Zebra and Wasp</i> and complete "Assessment Questions" (Part A/B).</p> <p>Wednesday: Access Common Lit: Reread <i>Zebra and Wasp</i> and complete "Discussion Question" Use your R.A.C.E strategy to write your answer in paragraph form. Your child will choose ONLY 1 "Discussion Question" to answer! Have your child write their paragraph on paper. Please take a picture of their paragraph and send via Remind.</p>
Math	<p>Monday, April 6 1.) Login to Clever.com account and go to ZEARN. Complete mission 3, lesson 1 in Zearn. **This is not where your child was previously in Zearn. They have been moved back by their teacher to get a review of previous skills that have been covered in class.</p> <p>Tuesday, April 7 1.) Login to Clever.com. Click on BrainPop jr. Go to Math, click on multiplication and division. Select "arrays." Watch video and complete easy quiz after. You can also have your child complete the hard quiz if you would like. 2.) After video and quiz, click and complete "write about it" and "activity." Have your child write their answers on a piece of paper. You can send a picture of their answers either via email or through the Remind app.</p> <p>Wednesday, April 8 1.) Login to Clever.com and go to ZEARN. Complete mission 3, lesson 2 in Zearn.</p> <p>Thursday, April 9 1.) Login to Clever.com. Click on BrainPop Jr. Go to "Math" and click "multiplication and division." Click on "repeated addition." Watch video and complete easy quiz. You can also have your child complete the hard quiz if you would like. 2.) After video and quiz, click and complete "write about it" and "activity." Have your child write their answers on a piece of paper. You can send a picture of their answers either via email or you can send it to them through the Remind app.</p> <p>Friday, April 10 1.) Login to Clever.com and go to ZEARN. Complete mission 3, lesson 3 in Zearn.</p>

SCIENCE	<p><u>Activity 1</u> Go to www.ck12.org. Click on 3rd Grade Science. Click 2.0 Earth Science. Click 2.3 Fossils of Plants and Animals. Read article and view images. Answer questions 1-4 at end of passage. Please feel free to send a picture of your child’s answers to your child’s teacher via email or remind app for feedback.</p> <p><u>Activity 2</u> Login to Clever and go to BrainPop Jr. Click on animals, then frogs. Watch video and complete easy quiz. You can try hard quiz also if you’re up for the challenge. After video and quizzes, complete “Write About It” activity on a piece of paper. After you complete your writing, draw a picture at the bottom of your page that shows the labeled stages of the life cycle of a frog. Each stage should be labeled and have a drawing. Please send a picture of your answers and drawing to your teacher via email or the remind app.</p> <p><u>Activity 3</u> Go to apps.learning.amplify.com/elementary. Username: sciencestudentcovid19@tryamplify.net Password: COVID2019 Click on Plant and Animal Defenses. Click on the book “Frog Models.” Click arrows to read the book. Think of a different animal besides frogs that uses camouflage to protect itself from predators. Some examples include lizards, snakes, and the arctic fox. You can also use an animal of your own choosing. Pretend that you are one of that type of animal and write a story about a day you had to use camouflage to protect yourself from a predator. Even though you aren’t a frog, you can still use details from that book in your story to show how animals use camouflage. Once story is complete, you can send a picture of story to your child’s teacher via email or the remind app. We are so excited to read all of the creative stories!!</p>
