

Lakeview 2020 Strong Start Plan

Boarding Bus

Students will also wear a mask when boarding the bus.

Buses will observe Covid 19 guidelines for capacity and airflow. Temperature shall be checked at the North entrance, South entrance, and West entrance of the building.

District's bus drivers will thoroughly wipe down each school bus each evening and monitoring each bus student for signs of potential illness by temperature checks

Entrance into school

Each student shall wear a mask upon entering the building.

Student shall be given appropriate mask if inappropriate mask is worn to school.

Each student should have their temperature checked upon entering the school building.

Junior high bus students shall enter the building through the West entrance.

High school bus students shall enter the building through the second West entrance.

Car rider students shall enter the building through the north entrance of the building.

After the tardy bell rings all traffic into the building shall be reverted to the main building entrance on the west side of the building.

Entrance into the building shall be granted through buzzer by the secretary after the tardy bell rings.

All water fountains will be disconnected to eliminate areas where the opportunity for cross contamination is significant.

Students will be encouraged to bring a bottle of water to school.

Breakfast and Lunch

High school students will report directly to their classrooms upon entering the building for student attendance check and breakfast.

Junior High school students will report directly to their classrooms upon entering the building for student attendance check and breakfast. The cafeteria supervisor shall serve breakfast in classrooms each morning.

School Food Services will wipe down and disinfect all areas (and surrounding areas) where food is prepared each school day in the cafeteria.

During phase 2 and 3 virtual students will be able to pick up meals at the school site. Meals will be picked up at from 12:00 PM until 12:30 PM. At the front door of the glass entrance of the cafeteria.

Class transfer

Teachers will monitor for no more than 25 percent of students are in the hall at any given class transfer time. All direction of class transfer traffic will be one-way (contraflow).

Junior high student shall remain in static groups for all core classes. Transitions shall only be for PE classes and electives where teachers shall walk students to class.

All students, teachers and faculty shall practice social distancing at all times

Per Covid 19 guidelines static groups shall not exceed 25 students per group

Students will be divided into A-DAY / B-DAY academic groups. On A-DAY (Tuesday and Thursday) half of the school's population will attend with face to face instruction simultaneously B-DAY students will receive instruction at home virtually. On B-DAY (Wednesday and Friday) half of the school's population will attend with face to face instruction. Simultaneously B-DAY students will receive instruction at home virtually.

Direct instruction, guided practice, and tests will occur on days when students have face to face class.

Independent work, projects, and reports will be done on days when students attend class remotely.

High school classes class sizes will be reduced from an average of 25 to an average of 13 students.

On the days that the students remain home to attend class remotely, attendance will be checked based on students logging in to each class using the established platform of Google classroom.

Janitorial and custodial

On Mondays the janitorial staff may use the time to deep clean and detail sanitize the school. Teachers may be scheduled for professional developments, grading's, lesson plans and parent conferences.

We are also increasing the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting high-touch areas in all of our buildings using disinfectants proven effective against COVID-19 as recommended by the EPA and CDC.

End of day dismissal

Students shall be dismissed at the end of the day by calling individual classes for dismissal. Students shall be dismissed into hall's through teachers monitoring and contraflow. All student traffic shall flow one way to the bus line and loading buses.

Symptoms of COVID-19

Students and staff who show symptoms of COVID-19 will be required to wear masks and wait in an isolated room until they can leave school.

Public health officials wrote that the guidelines are “based on the best available public health data at this time, international best practices

If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, the principal shall contact the school boards personnel office. That could include the closure of specific classrooms or offices and a 14-day quarantine period for those exposed.

Soft start procedure

Lakeview Junior Senior High School will implement the soft start procedure for school startup for Covid 19. Students shall report A through E on Monday. D through J on Tuesday. K through O on Wednesday. P through T on Thursday and U through Z on Friday.

Building preparation

Install thermal temperature scanners, install water bottle fillers to replace some of the water fountains, purchase of sanitation products, implement building foggers, purchase and preparation of Covid 19 sanitation products

Device disimination

Students will be issued iPads for virtual instruction. iPads will be provided by the district to virtual students. Parents will be advised that YouTube on in NPSB videos are available for how-to videos. Parents will be advised of district determined hotspots for students without Internet service at home
