



**Parish to Participate in Summer Food Service Program  
for the 20-21 School Year**

**Natchitoches Parish School Board today** announced an amendment to its policy for serving meals to students under the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs for the 2020-2021 school year. Natchitoches Parish will be participating in the Summer Food Service Program. Meals will be provided free of charge to all enrolled students at their school.

Acceptance and participating requirements are the same regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, disability, age reprisal or or retaliation for prior civil rights activity in any program or activity conducted or funded by USDA, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service. Meals will be provided at the sites and times as follows:

The letter must contain the complainant's name, address, telephone number, and a written description of the alleged discriminatory action in sufficient detail to inform the Assistant Secretary for Civil Rights (ASCR) about the nature and date of an alleged civil rights violation.
